

Towards Internalisation of the University of Gdańsk

Internalisation of the University is a complex process which requires a systemic and strategic approach. The degree of internalisation should not be measured solely on the rate of imported students. In addition to this, internalisation involves: a broad didactic proposal offered to foreigners, academic development based on the interchange of scholarly experience and mobility of scholars, international promotion, foreigners-friendly provisions which involve neither linguistic nor cultural barriers.

The University of Gdańsk is the most comprehensive higher education institution in the region of Pomorze. It intermingles innovation with tradition, and systematically undertakes activities that aim at upgrading the level of internationalisation. There are three most prominent directions of these procedures: scientific, educational and administrative.
